A. About Edward M. Kennedy Center (EMK Center):

Edward M. Kennedy Center (EMK Center) for Public Service and the Arts engages, inspires, connects, and empowers citizens of all ages. Created in 2012 through a partnership between the Liberation War Museum and the American Center of U.S. Embassy Dhaka, the EMK Center is a non-partisan platform committed to open dialogue, informed action, individual and artistic expression, and personal and professional development. We define public service as service on behalf of the people – by anyone, anywhere, anytime.

B. Background:

Since inauguration, EMK Center has played a vital role in developing a space that is accessible to all, and it strives continuously to provide value to its participants, and allows for a diversity of individual and artistic expression to flourish. The Center extends support to any organization or individual who is willing to dedicate time and effort to bring about change through entrepreneurship and the engagement of youth. The Center's objective is to connect individuals and organizations to each other, support them, and create a synergy that is beneficial to Bangladesh both in the short and the long run.

The world changes every few years. The education system is not what it was 5 years ago and students today have to train harder and approach learning in a more practical manner. They no more have the convenience of adhering to academic learning. The fast-paced technological advancements and the growing global industries have required students to be more creative and innovative.

The students of this era thus need to be taught to think more freely and creatively. The society needs to prepare them in a manner that they become the ultimate generation that can easily adapt to changes, take on new challenges, and keep innovation thriving. EMK Center, as a carrier and builder of creativity and entrepreneurship, wants to introduce students to entrepreneurial mindset. Through this workshop, the EMK Center aims to build a bridge between a student's thinking process and entrepreneurship. Many students choose to open their own enterprise after completing education and this competition will act as a tool that will aid them in their future endeavors.

C. Purpose of the RFP:

The "Beyond Grades" project is first of its kind in Bangladesh. It is a concise form of mentorship that is to be awarded to students who possess a creative mind that thinks about the betterment of society. The learning phase of the campaign is a way to bring forth the best entrepreneurial minds of the youngsters of the country. The mentorship will then provide those minds a way to hone their skills. Through the mentorship, EMK Center aims to instill a correct entrepreneurial concept among 40 students (per batch) of the country at a young age. This will help to nurture their "self-made" skills and intellects and drive it towards a more sensible and enterprising point of view.

D. Scope of Work:

- i) Creating curriculum for building entrepreneurial mindset among preteens
- ii) Weekly 4 hours of mentorship sessions online (2 hours each day on 2 specific days of the week) to school-going children
- iii) The individual/ firm shall prepare a Final Report, incorporating comments from EMK Center
- iv) The individual/ firm shall maintain complete confidentiality of all data and documents provided by EMK Center.

E. Deliverable:

- 1. Curriculum to develop entrepreneurial mindset
- 2. A draft report followed by a presentation for discussion with EMK Center Management
- 3. A final report following discussion and feedback from EMK Center

F. Duration of the assignment:

The task is expected to be completed within 90-days from the date of signing the contract. The individual/firm, therefore, is required to prepare and submit the entire plan in a way that allows the achievement of all deliverables within 60-days period.
